

Workers' Compensation and Disability Insurance Requirements for Permitted Facilities

One or more of the following forms must accompany the application to document compliance with the Worker's Compensation Law:

When Worker's Comp and/or Disability coverage IS provided.

Proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance:

- One of these
- **Form C-105.2** – Certificate of Worker's Compensation Insurance (**Contact your Insurance carrier**; they will have to generate this form. If you prefer you can have them **fax it directly to our office at 607-737-2059**, but make sure it lists the name of your facility as it appears in our records)
Note: Form **C-105** is not acceptable proof, must be form **C-105.2**
 - OR
 - **Form U-26.3** – Certificate of Workers' Compensation Insurance (Issued by the **State Insurance Fund**, you will have to contact them. If you prefer you can have them **fax it directly to our office at 607-737-2059** but make sure it lists the name of your facility as it appears in our records);
 - OR
 - **Form SI-12** – Certificate of Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance (usually only applies to major corporations or government agencies).
 - OR
 - **GSI – 105.2** – Certificate of Participation in Workers' Compensation Group Self-Insurance (usually only applies to major corporations or government agencies).

AND

Proof of Disability Benefits Insurance:

- One of these
- **DB-120.1** - Certificate of Disability Benefits (**Contact your Insurance carrier**, they will have to generate this form. If you prefer you can have them **fax it directly to our office at 607-737-2059**, but make sure it lists the name of your facility as it appears in our records)
Note: Form **DB-120** is not acceptable proof, must be form **DB-120.1**
 - OR
 - **Form DB-155** – Certificate of Disability Benefits Self-Insurance Insurance (usually only applies to major corporations or government agencies).
 - If your Government Agency has Worker's Compensation Insurance but does not have Disability Benefits Insurance you must complete a form **CE-200** Exemption form for the Disability Benefits requirements and submit it with your application.

Important: Acord Forms are not acceptable as proof of insurance coverage.

When Worker's Comp and/or Disability coverage IS NOT provided.

- **Form CE-200** – Certificate of Attestation of **Exemption** from NYS Workers' Compensation and/or Disability Benefits Coverage. (*See attached instruction sheet for details on how to obtain this form*)

Note: Permits will not be issued without the above paperwork.
