Tracking and Monitoring People

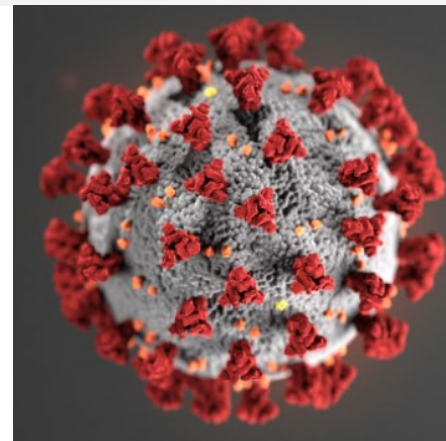
