**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH OR SECURELY CONFINED. ALL CATS AND FERRETS MUST BE SECURELY CONFINED. ALL PETS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT WHO IS ABLE TO HOLD THE PET DURING VACCINATION.**

- **Young pets:** Puppies, kittens, and ferrets **must be at least 3 months of age.**
- **Initial vaccinations** are effective for only one year. Pets must be re-vaccinated one year after initial vaccination.
- **Previously vaccinated dogs & cats:** Bring proof of vaccination to the clinic to receive a rabies certificate that is good for 3 years\*. If no proof provided, the certificate will expire in one year.
- **Ferret vaccinations:** Ferrets must be vaccinated annually.
- **Pregnant or nursing animals:** May not be vaccinated if attending veterinarian refuses.
- **Duplicate certificates:** Duplicate certificates may be purchased at the Chemung County Health Department for a **fee of \$10.00.** Certificates are needed for licensing, interstate travel and accurate record keeping.
- **Clinics are for New York State residents only.**
- Routine veterinary care is recommended for all pets.
- Vaccinations are **FREE**, but **donations are greatly appreciated!**

**\* REMEMBER TO BRING PROOF OF PREVIOUS VACCINATION FOR YOUR CAT OR DOG in order to receive a rabies certificate good for 3 years.**
